give notice that I have the following disclosable pecuniary interests. These disclosable interests apply to me **and/or** my partner (which means spouse or civil partner or a person with whom I am living as such) of which I am aware and which I am required to declare under the Council's Code of Conduct. 1. Employment, Office, Trade, Profession or Vocation carried out for profit or gain, including the name of any person or body who employs or has appointed me.

6. Corporate Tenancies: any tenancy where, to my knowledge, the Council is the landlord and the tenant is a body in which I have a beneficial interest.

business or land in the Parish and **either** the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital, **or** one hundredth of the total issued share capital of any class of shares issued.

8.1. I recognise that it is a breach of the Council's Code of Conduct to:

- (1) omit information that ought to be given in this notice;
- (2) provide information that is materially false or misleading;
- 3) fail to give further notices in order to
 - a) bring up to date information given in this notice; or
 - b) notify a disclosable interest that I acquire after the date of this notice;

and that any breach of the Code of Conduct can be referred to the Standards Committee.

8.2 I understand that failure (without reasonable excuse) to register or disclose any disclosable pecuniary interest in accordance with the relevant Acts is a criminal offence and risks a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale (currently £5,000) or disqualification as a member for a period not exceeding 5 years.

Note:

- 1. Where a disclosable interest relates only to your partner you are still required to disclose it.
- 2. Where you consider that information relating to any of your interests is a 'Sensitive Interest' you need not include that interest provided you have consulted with the Monitoring Officer and he/she agrees that it need not be included. A 'Sensitive Interest' is an interest which could create or is likely to create a serious risk that you or a person connected with you may be subjected to violence or intimidation.
- 3. Where the interest is no longer a 'Sensitive Interest' you must notify the Monitoring Officer within 28 days of that change.
- 4. This form gives general guidance but is not comprehensive. The Council's Code of Conduct gives precise requirements. Current Acts and Regulations should be referred to where necessary. Continuation sheets should be used where needed and clearly marked.
