### **Reconstruction of Middle Drove Overbridge, Accommodation Road**

We wanted to let you know that we will be working to reconstruct the bridge, where Accommodation Road crosses the railway line.

We will start works on 8 August 2022 and plan to be complete by December 2022. From 5 September 2022, a section of Accommodation Road will be closed for 14 weeks, while we reconstruct the bridge and work on and around the bridge.

Our hours of work will generally be as below, but please be aware these may change;

<b>Dates of shifts</b>
<p><b>Monday – Friday 7.30am – 5.30</b>  <b>We will also be working some weekends while the railway is closed</b>  <b>10pm Saturday – 8am Sunday</b></p>
<p><b>Accommodation Road closed at Middle Drove over bridge</b>  <b>Monday 5 September – Friday 9 December</b></p>
<p><b>The railway will be closed from</b>  <b>11.15pm Saturday 17 September – 5am Saturday 24 September 22 and we will be</b>  <b>working 24 hours a day</b></p>

When the railway is closed we will have large machines working, which can be noisy and we apologise if you are disturbed over this time.

Access will be maintained to homes/businesses and diversion routes will be in place in advance of the closures. However, there will be no access over the railway bridge on Accommodation Road.
